This right applies at all times, for example during immigration proceedings, housing decisions or the child's day-to-day home life.</p>
Gurveer Singh	<p>Article 23 (children with a disability) A child with a disability has the right to live a full and decent life with dignity and, as far as possible, independence and to play an active part in the community. Governments must do all they can to support disabled children and their families.</p>
