We can help to stop or prevent online bullying by:



- Always let a brusted adult know it something is warrying










Make sure you go on age appropriate games, because they could contain violence.

Never share your password with anyone apart from your family.

Be wary if any games or websites ask for personal details. Ask a trusted adult.

Don't go on 18 rated games if you are seven.

Make sure you don't click on a link that looks too suspicious because it might be a scam.

> If the domain name is a well known organisation, then it is probably trustworthy.
