



- Read to your children
- Ask lots of questions and share opinions

Talking

Talk to your child as much as possible and 'feed' them new and ambitious vocabulary.

"Let's eat our lunch now." "Let's munch our lunch now." "Let's scoff our lunch now." "Let's devour our lunch now!"

You're looking ... not just... but...



Vocabulary

Enrich conversations through description:

"Look at that rain. It looks like little diamonds sparkling on the window pane!"

Have fun with words and language.

"I'm as hot as a spud in a cooking pot!"

Praise your child for using new words or interesting phrases
